Dear Dog Owner:

As the New Year approaches, it is time once again to renew your dogs license. This letter is notification that your dog's license will expire December 31, 2010. The City of Pendleton tracks owner and dog information on a data base system and requires any changes to be reported. The annual fee for a neutered/spayed dog is \$10 or \$20 if not neutered/spayed. Replacement tags are available for \$5 after the **new** permanent tag has been issued.

You may license your dog through the year in which your dog's rabies vaccination expires. An example of how the licensing system works is as follows:

- A neutered/spayed dog has rabies expiration in November 2011; with proof of rabies vaccination you may pay \$20 for licensing thru December 2011
- The same would be true for a dog that is not neutered/spayed but the fee is \$20 per year; equaling \$40 for licensing thru December 2011.
- The maximum possible renewal is three years.

You can renew your dogs license at the City of Pendleton-Finance office or by mailing the completed form, fee and proof of rabies vaccination to: The City of Pendleton, 500 SW Dorion, Pendleton, OR 97801. All renewals received by mail will not receive their new tags until they have been processed in our database system.
