**Construction – 2019**

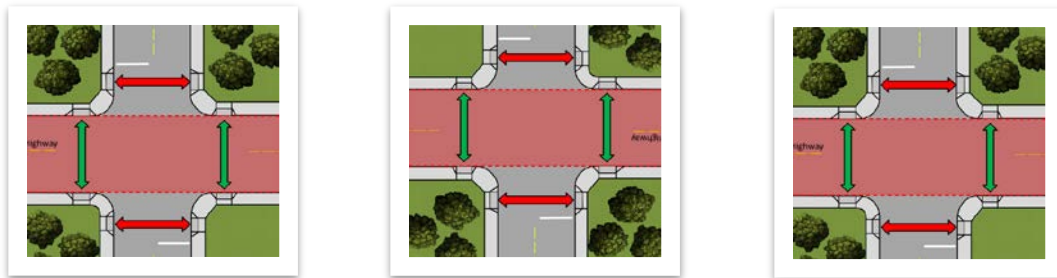

Construction of the project is planned for 2019 along the Emigrant Avenue portion of the U.S. 395 couplet between SW Fifth Street and SW Ninth Street.
