New Business:

- Crdinance 3994 Amending Ordinance 3382 and 3848, the Dog Regulation and Nuisance Ordinances: This is a housekeeping measure. In March 2022, the Council approved amendments to the Uniform Development Code, which included changes in the regulation of animals. The substance of the changed animal provisions conflict, to some degree, with the City's Dog Control Ordinance and the animal related provisions of the City's Nuisance Ordinance. This ordinance amends the dog and nuisance ordinances to reconcile the conflicts. On a first reading, no vote is taken.
- M Ameresco LED Street Light Invoice : In December 2021, City Council authorized a 10-year payback plan for the for the Street Light LED Conversion Project of up to \$710,000. Staff recommended paying off that loan early, which saves \$165,725 on finance charges, which can be applies to street preservation.
- **N** ODOT Cooperative Improvement Agreement No. 33661 – ADA Ramps and RRFB Installation – Amendment : The City and ODOT have a cooperative agreement where ODOT reimburses the City for ADA ramps the City reconstructs along state highways, as long as they pass inspection. This amendment includes provisions for additional projects.
