Public Hearing:

 Annual Fee Resolution 2888: *Every year, the City reviews the Fee Schedule that establishes the rates charged for a wide variety of services, such as aquatic center rentals, legal document preparation, and interment services at Olney Cemetery. Each department head is asked to review the specific fees associated with their department and make recommendations for change as appropriate.*


Bid Awards:

 Tutuilla Sewer Line Project: *Award the SW Tutuilla Road Sewer Line construction project to Precision Paving Plus, LLC, for \$276,407.75*

 Ladder Truck Purchase: *Authorized purchase of a new platform aerial ladder truck through a lease-to-own contract with Hughes Fire of Springfield. The fire department would pay \$165,675.88 a year for 15 years.*

New Business:

- ◆ Federal grant presentation: *CFM Advocates presented on the 2023 Federal Agenda and Legislative Update, including projects they will lobby for funding, grant requests, and policy priorities.*
- ◆ Planning Commission Annual Update: *A representative from the Planning Commission presented about 2022 city planning activities*

- ◆ Annual Capital Improvement Update on Sewer Collection : *An annual report on the progress toward accomplishing the projects identified in the 2015 Sewer Collection Master Plan during this past year.*

 First Reading of Ordinance 3995, Adding Provision to Regulate RVs in Public Places: *This ordinance amends the traffic ordinance and addresses the use of RVs for living purposes on public streets. No vote is taken on first reading.*
