New Business:

 *Sports Complex Concept: Joseph Hull, representing the Round-Up City Development Corporation, approached the council requesting a donation of 40 acres of city property off Airport Way to be used in the development of a sports complex. Council directed city staff to research and present a proposal on the matter at the next meeting.*

 *Award for Water System Insertion Valves: Council awarded a bid of \$51,973 to Tap Master, Inc, for two water insertion valves. These valves, in the area of town between SW Hailey Ave, SW 30th Street, and Houtama Road will allow staff to perform maintenance and repairs within that area of the water system without shutting off water to the area, which would impact up to 600 water customers.*

◆ *Library Board Presentation : A representative from the Library Board presented about activities for the past year, including grant funding and community partnerships.*

◆ *Aquatic Center Annual Report: Staff presented on operations, revenue, and updates for the Aquatic Center over the past year.*

◆ *Annual Safety Committee Report: Representatives from the city's Safety Committee updated City Council about activities for the past year, including water refill stations, homeless camps, and staff education.*
