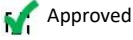

Community Discussion:

- ◆ *No community discussion presented*

Consent Agenda: *The consent agenda groups routine meeting actions into a single agenda item so they can be approved in one step, rather than in multiple motions.*

- ✓ *Minutes of the Sept. 5, 2023, City Council meeting; announcement of executive session to discuss real property.*

Public Hearings

- ⚠ *Ordinance 4003, Relating to Municipal Court becoming a Court of Record: Municipal Court Judge Blaine Clooten gave the staff report outlining the reasons for the proposal; Michael Breiling raised concerns about costs and fees, interpreters, and the court relationship with defendants. Council member Sally Brandsen motioned to table the ordinance for additional research.*

Bids

- ✓ *Consideration of bids for cardiac monitors: Authorizes the Fire Department to spend \$154,000 to purchase three Zoll Cardiac Monitors for ambulances.*

New Business

- ◆ *Ordinance 4004, Amending the Traffic Ordinance 3238, as to Parking Provisions: The present ordinance prohibits parking in a public place for more than 72 hours, and this amendment would reduce the permitted parking time to 48 hours. This amendment also adds a prohibition against sleeping and living in vehicles except as allowed by the resting ordinance. No vote is taken on a first reading.*

Additional Comments

- ◆ *It was announced the Pendleton UAS Range received a grant for \$2.25 mil to establish a Center of Excellence*
