Bids

 Connector Road Waterlines Project—Rotschy Inc.: *Rotschy Inc was the low bidder with an estimate of \$4.03 million to install a new domestic waterline in the area known as the Rees-Goad property. The engineering estimate was \$6 million, which will allow additional projects to be completed.*

 3/4 minus trench backfill rock to American Rock Products: *Pendleton Public Works has a need for ¾ minus rock throughout the year to backfill utility cuts in the road system. This authorizes up to \$200,000 to pay for rock throughout the 2024 construction season.*

Public Hearings and related ordinances

 Public Hearing of Ordinance 4007 to amend Ordinance 3845, the UDC, and Ordinance 3442, Comp Plan: *This ordinance would change 54.97 acres of land recently annexed into city limits off Goad Road from Exclusive Farm Use to M-1 Light Industrial for development. Council will vote on re-zoning portions of the land to R-1 in January. No public testimony was presented.*

New Business

- ◆ First Reading of Ordinance 4004, amending Ordinance 3238, an ordinance controlling vehicular and pedestrian traffic: *Ordinance 3238 regulates elements of Taxi Business and special parking permits for a variety of purposes, including special parking permits for construction projects in the downtown. This transfers responsibility for overseeing this program to the Police Department. No vote is taken on a first reading.*
- ◆ First Reading of Ordinance 3898, Amending the Street Tree Ordinance. Pressure Zones—Assessment and Design Concept: *This seven-month assessment would outline design and construction considerations for a project to address some fire flow deficiencies and stagnant water in the Skyline pressure system and allow for potential service to a new higher level pressure zone for development north of the existing City Limits. The task order allows for up to \$145,033. No vote is taken on a first reading*
