**A commercial burn permit allows only the following:**

Waste from offices, wholesale or retail yards and outlets, warehouses, restaurants, mobile home parks, and dwellings containing more than 4 family living units such as apartments, condominiums, hotels, motels or dormitories.

**Open burning shall not take place unless the following is strictly adhered to:**

**Fire extinguishing equipment:** A garden hose connected to a water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment approved by the Fire Marshal shall be readily available for immediate use at open burning sites.

**Attendance:** Burning material shall be constantly attended by a responsible person or an expressly authorized agent knowledgeable in the use of the required fire extinguishing equipment and familiar with the limitations of the burning permit, until the fire has been extinguished dead out.

**Location:** Open burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any structure or other combustible material. Conditions that could cause the fire to spread to within 50 feet of a structure (dry grass, etc.) shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

**Open Burning Hours:** On designated burn days, no open burn shall be ignited before 7:30 am. All open flame shall be extinguished **DEAD OUT (cold to the touch)** no later than 1 hour after sunset including smoldering piles of ashes or unburned material.

**Offensive Odors:** Burning of any type that unreasonably disturbs other people by offensive odors is a violation of DEQ rules and is prohibited.

**DEQ Permit:** An "Open Burn Permit" must be obtained from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality prior to issuance of this burn permit.

*The above named person has been advised of all regulations and conditions pertaining to open burning in the City of Pendleton or Fire Districts protected by Pendleton Fire and Ambulance Service and, by signing this permit, agrees to comply with all open burning regulations and conditions contained herein, and in the brochure titled "Open Burning, regulations for safely conducting open burning in the City of Pendleton and Fire Districts protected by Pendleton Fire and Ambulance Service".*

If you have any questions or concerns regarding this permit or our open burning policy, please contact the Fire Marshal at 276-1442 **prior** to igniting a fire. A copy of the policy in its entirety is available at Fire Station No. 1, 911 SW Court.
